



## Elementary Dress Code

Students in Kindergarten, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grades attending Pontiac Academy for Excellence are required to comply with the dress code as follows:

### **Tops-**

**Boys** – Solid color shirts with collars, Rugby or golf style shirts are acceptable - burgundy, black, white or gold (no tee shirts, sweatshirts, or jerseys). Solid color sweaters (burgundy, black, gold or white) may be worn over your shirts (shirt collars must show above the sweater).

**Girls**– Solid color shirts with collars, Dress blouses, Rugby or golf style shirts are acceptable -burgundy, black, white or gold (no tee shirts, sweatshirts, or jerseys, no midriff shirts, no sleeveless, no halters, and no spaghetti straps).

Solid color sweaters (burgundy, black, white or gold) may be worn over your blouses (shirt collars must show above the sweater, absolutely no sweatshirts).

### **Black/Tan Bottoms-**

**Boys-** Black or tan slacks, corduroys or dress slacks (no jeans, sweat pants, or running gear) No saggy, low riding, torn, or exposed under garments will be allowed.

Shirts must be tucked in and a belt is required on all slacks with belt loops. Belts will have a standard professional belt buckle (no logo, rhinestone, neon, or flashing billboard buckles allowed) All belts will be worn at the appropriate waist height of the trouser.

Black or tan knee length shorts (May – June **only**).

**Girls**– Black or tan slacks, corduroys, jumpers or skirts

(Skirts and jumpers must be no more than 2” above the knee). All slacks and skirts with belt loops WILL require an appropriate belt. Belts will have a standard professional belt buckle (no logo, rhinestone, neon, or flashing billboard buckles allowed) All belts will be worn at the appropriate waist height of the garment.

Black or tan capri style and knee length shorts (May – June **only**).

### **Shoes -**

**Boys & Girls** - Black or tan Dress/Casual shoes (no heels above 1”, no open toes, and no open heels). Gym shoes will be permitted as long as they remain neat and clean.

### **Hosiery -**

**Boys-** socks should be appropriate to attire, dress or casual socks (no bare feet in shoes).

**Girls-** Hosiery should be appropriate to your attire, anklets, knee socks, or tights, (no bare feet in shoes).

### **PLEASE NOTE:**

**It is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that their children are in accordance with the school dress code daily. Parents will be notified if students are not in compliance. Students arriving at school out of dress code compliance will not be allowed in class. Any questions or concerns may be directed to the main office or the school deans.**
